If the postmark, email date or fax date indicates that a registration form was sent late, it will be accepted upon payment of a fine of \$15 per working day late to a maximum of \$150. The Organizing Committee will retain the full amount of the late registration fines. If the Organizing Committee cannot prove that the application was submitted late, the team will not be subject to the fine. However, if an athlete is to be added to the roster after the date, the addition may be subject to a penalty of \$5 per athlete.

Registration and event fees must be paid before the end of the event to the organizing club. Failure to pay will result in a \$20 fine per team to the organizing club or organization.

Diving Lists: Deadline: By Monday, June 6, 2022

To facilitate the task of the organizing committee, the dive sheets must be filled out electronically via the Rezman sheet generator program.

RULES

FINA, Diving Plongeon Canada and Plongeon Quebec Rulebooks

In accordance with the *DIVING PLONGEON CANADA* By-Laws:

- Dive sheets, sent electronically, will now be considered signed by the diver and coach. Paper dive sheets will only be used to submit changes.
- When discrepancies are discovered during the competition, the last dive sheet sent will be considered the official copy.

Please note that in accordance with Diving Quebec Regulation Q12:

- When arriving at the competition site, each club must have in its possession the "summary" sheet of all entries made on Rezman. This will serve as a check, in case of
- Sheets not submitted no later than 24 hours prior to the start of the event will be accepted upon receipt of a \$25 fine, payable to the host club.
- The host committee is responsible for posting, prior to the first event of the day, the lists for each of the events of the day of competition. Divers must then initialize their list if everything is in order. However, if an error is found in a list, the diver must go to the secretariat to make the changes as soon as possible.
- The diver is allowed to make one or more changes to his dive sheet up to 1 hour before either the start of his event or the scheduled/announced start time of his event, whichever comes first.
